



# Particles Cheat Sheet

## 조사 정리표

Particles are tiny tags attached to nouns that tell you their job in the sentence. Master these and Korean suddenly clicks.

Particle	Use	Example
은 / 는	topic marker	저는 (as for me)
이 / 가	subject marker	고양이가 (the cat)
을 / 를	object marker	밥을 (rice, obj.)
에	to / at (place, time)	학교에 (to school)
에서	at / from (action place)	집에서 (at home)
의	possessive ("s")	친구의 (friend's)
와 / 과	and / with	친구와 (with a friend)
도	also / too	저도 (me too)
만	only	물만 (only water)

## Quick rule

Choose the form by the last sound of the noun: use 은/이/을/과 after a consonant, and 는/가/를/와 after a vowel.
